## HAPPENINGS: Youth Revival Camp/New Season

Take a deep breath. Do you smell that? Change is in the air at The Exchange Church, stirring our spirits to lean more into His heartbeat as a Church family. Here's what God has been up to in our Church family and where He's leading us!

How was camp this year? Glory to glory would be the only way to describe the way God met us during our time at Youth Revival Camp this year. There were so many testimonies of physical, emotional, and spiritual healing within the hearts and minds of our young saints, testimonies that marked their walk with Jesus and that they will carry with them into every season with Him. His work didn't stop at camp—He was only getting started. When we returned home, students were hungry for the word of God and are ready to go wherever His presence leads them.

With all of these spiritual manifestations and gifts, sometimes we're left wondering "what now?" When we experience an incredible encounter and find ourselves shaking under the power of God, what happens when we get up off the ground and go back to real life? What happens when we go home? What happens when we're back in our schools and faced with the same trials? Do we check into His presence and check out? Do we wait for camp next year? Do we partner with the lies of the enemy as he tries to convince us that the

change was only temporary? Do we live waiting for feelings? By. No. Means.

This is where the real journey begins, when we enter into the mission field with Him. This is when His Spirit is at His best work in us and when we receive the opportunity to know Him even deeper. We do this by following the fruit of the spirit and measuring the fruit in our own lives. We measure fruit, NOT manifestations. We welcome the manifestations, and we welcome the gifts, but they are not indicators of progress in our walk with Christ. Gifts and manifestations are given out of the grace and mercy of who He is, while the fruits of the Spirit are witnessed by the day-by-day surrender to the leading of His spirit. So what fruits are we witnessing and sensing in our community of young saints as they return from Youth Camp?

Even at camp we could see that there is a specific season that many of our young people are walking into, and that is a season of pruning and prayer. One of the most asked questions at Camp was "Why can't I feel God's presence the way that I used to? Did I do something wrong?" So many Christians face this season, which was referred to by Martin Luther and many other heroes of the faith as "The Dark Night of the Soul," otherwise known as a kind of "Pruning" as Jesus referred to it. A

deeper understanding of this can be found in an excerpt from an amazing article on page 2, but in brief, this is "a season in our apprenticeship to Jesus where he intentionally takes away the felt sense of his presence in order to do a deep work of purgation and preparation in our soul for a greater freedom, love, and intimacy with God."—







# PARENT'S CORNER: About the Dark Night

#### What a dark night is:

A season in our apprenticeship to Jesus where he intentionally takes away the felt sense of his presence in order to do a deep work of purgation and preparation in our soul for a greater freedom, love, and intimacy with God. An experience of God that feels more like absence than presence. It's unlearning, as much as it's learning. Less of an experience, more of a non-experience. A place where our faith is given an opportunity for testing and refining.

A transformation of desire. From love of things/sensuality, to love of God/spirituality. This process involves self-denial, detachment, prayer, growth in virtue, and the adjustment of our loves and longings for a greater experience of God.

# Feelings you may experience in a dark night:

"Regression. Like I'm going backward emotionally and spiritually."

"I've done something wrong."

"Things that were once life-giving (spiritual or otherwise) are now dull and uninteresting. The spiritual disciplines feel boring and dry."

"God has abandoned me." "God isn't real." "This is forever."

Yet still: desire for God runs deep.

What's actually happening:

Progression: God is freeing me from attachments and anxieties.

God is freeing me from misplaced confidence in ideas about God, feelings of God, and formulas for how to become like God, and instead gracing me with trust in himself.

God is preparing me for the next stage in my life with him and in the world.

My desires for sin are going down, but desire for God is going up.

"The passive night of the senses involves God's own action upon the soul in question. As the person begins to strip away his inordinate sensual attraction to the things of this world, thus getting rid of the old-self, especially through prayer, mediation and self-denial, God then allows a profound period of spiritual aridity to best the believer, the ultimate purpose of which is to effectuate an even more powerful purification of our inordinate passion and desires, especially as these vices begin to manifest themselves on a spiritual level (as in a craving for spiritual delights and pleasures). It may or may not come as a surprise to you that China is the largest producer of Bibles in the world, as they've been the largest exporter of goods since 2009. The country exports Bibles to 70 other countries thanks to a partnership between the Amity Printing Company and United Bible Societies, who have distributed more than 160 million Bibles as of March 2017. That number may not rise as quickly as first anticipated though— CNN reports that earlier this year, Beijing pulled Bibles from online stores like Amazon in an effort to control religion.


